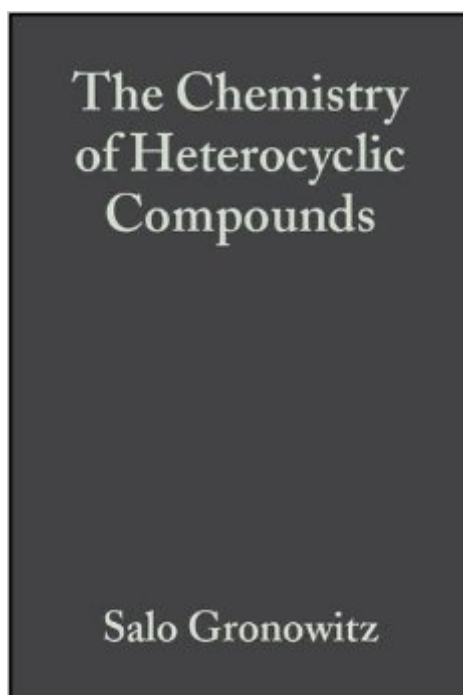


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Thiophene And Its Derivatives, Part 1 (The Chemistry Of Heterocyclic Compounds, Vol. 44)
