Well, this is another book that grabbed me right from the start, held me tight and didn't let me go right up until the very last page. Matt and Simone suffer one of the worst tragedies that could befit a married couple. Their six month old baby, Helena, is snatched when out in the park with Matt's mother. Fast forward 18 years and remarkably Matt and Simone are still together and have had no further children. Then, one day, Simone is approached by this young woman who claims to be Helena. She provides enough information and evidence for Simone to not dismiss this outright. What happens next is a veritable roller coaster of ups, downs, twists and turns culminating in an ending that, although I had an inkling, I really didn't expect to be right. Although not a particularly

long book, there is definitely nothing missing from this story. Strong, easy to emote with characters that I was definitely interested in enough to want to get to know. Strong punchy narrative which gets to the point without wasting time. Again, like with "The Girl With No Past", the author tells the story in the present with flashbacks to fill in the past. A couple of times I stopped during the book as I had a nagging doubt that what I was reading was actually credible. Would Simone really have done that. But then I paused and thought for a second and realised that Simone is a woman who has been holding on to hope for so long and when someone comes along who could actually BE her missing daughter, of course she will do anything for that person. The bond between mother and daughter really is that strong.

This is the first book by Kathryn Croft that I've read. I've heard many good things about her previous book. When I read the description for "The Girl You Lost" I was intrigued to say the least. ***Possibly some very minor spoilers*** As the book begins we are taken back eighteen years. Simone and Matt are a young couple adjusting to life as new parents in their tiny apartment. Matt is twenty-two and studying to be a doctor and for now nineteen-year-old Simone has put school on hold to raise their six-month old daughter, Helena. They are lucky though that Matt's mother, Miriam is around to help out. She frequently takes Helena out to give the young couple a bit of a break. Matt's mother comes to take Helena to the park one afternoon so Matt can study. The tired parents are happy to have a few moments to themselves. Just as they say how happy they are, how great everything is, the phone rings and their world is forever changed.. Helena is missing. The book then jumps to the present. Simone Porter is now a successful journalist and is married to Matt, who is now a doctor. Their daughter, Helena has been missing for eighteen years and they are no closer to finding her then they were before. That is until one day. Simone is approached by a young woman named Grace. Grace tells her she needs to talk to her about her missing daughter. Simone is hesitant as she's been fooled before by people who claim to have information about Helena. But she decides to hear what the young woman has to say. What Grace says gives Simone hope for the first time in years. But can she trust this woman? When Grace also goes missing Simone will do anything to find her and find out if what she says is true.

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
